We are pleased to invite you to support and share information about the **International Summer School on Remote Sensing 2026**, organised by the GIS and Remote Sensing Laboratory of the National Center “Junior Academy of Sciences of Ukraine”.

The school will take place from **June 8 to 16, 2026** in an online format via Zoom. Participation is free of charge.

The International Summer School on Remote Sensing is designed for school students aged 14–18 who are interested in science, technology, geography, environment, and space. The program will be held in English, so participants are expected to have at least a B1 / Intermediate level of English.

During the school, participants will learn how satellite imagery and geospatial data help us study the Earth without physical contact. They will explore how satellites are used to monitor climate change, urban growth, deforestation, water resources, natural hazards, and other environmental processes.

**The program will include:**

- ◆ 5 interactive classes
- ◆ 1 final project presentation day
- ◆ hands-on work with real satellite data and images
- ◆ team-based mini research projects
- ◆ communication with mentors and peers in an international learning environment

By the end of the school, participants will present the results of their own mini research projects and receive certificates of participation.
